NASAQ 2023 Club Championship guidelines:

-Participants must be a financial member of NASAQ at the beginning, throughout, and at the conclusion of the nominated Club Championship rounds to qualify.

-Participants must compete in 3 of 5 nominated Sporting Clay Trophy Competitions to qualify.

-If a Member participates in more than 3 competitions, their best 3 scores will be used.

-The 5 competitions will be the NASAQ regular monthly Sporting Clays Trophy Competitions held on the first Sunday in May/June/July/August/September.

-The annual Side by Side Competition held in June will NOT qualify.

-Should inclement weather reduce the number of competitions, the committee reserves the right to extend/reduce the number of competitions in the Club Championship.

At the conclusion of the Club Championship badges will be awarded to First Place in the following categories.
